### LARAWAY SCHOOL

#### ***Behavior Interventionists – Outdoor Adventure Education and Life Skills Focus! – Johnson & Hardwick, VT***

This position will provide daily educational and behavioral support to individual students in an alternative school setting; providing opportunities for youth to make positive choices, gain self-confidence and learn skills that are critical to their lifelong development. The Interventionist will provide support in social, recreational, and daily living skills in school, community and outdoor education settings. The positions will support individualized academic plans, classroom based activities; community based service learning and school-to-work initiatives. Bachelor degree, or pursuing Bachelor Degree, preferably in human services. May have relevant experience in exchange for human services degree. These positions are full time and offer a comprehensive compensation and benefits package.

***Summer, substitute, and part time opportunities also available.***

#### ***Special Education Case Manager – Johnson & Hardwick, VT***

The Special Education Case Manager will case manage all aspects of a student's services both special education and mental health while adhering to all state and federal regulations. This position supports the student, team, teachers and family in carrying out education and treatment goals. Special Education Licensure is required for this position and prior experience working with emotional and behavior disorders is preferred. This position will share time between our School locations.

### BACKPACK PROGRAM

#### ***Behavior Interventionists – Public School Based – Lamoille, Caledonia, Orleans, and Surrounding Counties in VT***

The Backpack Program is seeking skilled and motivated individuals to join our team. The interventionist will provide individualized support to a child or youth struggling to find success in public school due to social-emotional and behavioral challenges. Successful candidates will have enthusiasm and talent in implementing and engaging students in behavioral programming. Bachelor degree, or pursuing Bachelor Degree, preferably in human services. May have relevant experience in exchange for human services degree. These positions are full time and offer a comprehensive compensation and benefits package.

#### ***Tier 2 Case Manager – Morrisville, VT***

The Tier 2 Case Manager will develop and/or deliver ongoing school and community based assessment, treatment and support for children and youth experiencing a severe emotional disturbance and their families within the Tier 2 program. The Case Manager will provide direction to members of the child's treatment team, facilitate team meetings and provide service coordination, treatment planning, supervision and crisis intervention. Bachelor's Degree in human services or related field required. Two years of human service delivery with children and families is preferred. Prior experience with public school based intervention program preferred. Full time position including agency benefits package.

***Empowering Youth, Strengthening Families, Building Community***

***Behavior Consultant – Morrisville, VT***

This position will provide therapeutic behavioral consultation and development of treatment programming to Backpack Program clients in the application of treatment methods based upon the principals of Applied Behavior Analysis and Positive Behavioral Support. Provide consultation to Case Managers related to overall service coordination and service delivery of program clients. Provide clinical supervision to Behavior Interventionists. Candidates must have a Master's degree in Psychology, Mental Health, Education or related field, experience with Functional Behavior Assessments and writing Behavior Support Plans, training and experience in Applied Behavior Analysis, certified as BCABA or BCBA and have completed ABA 1 and 2 (or program equivalent).

**SUBSTITUTE CARE PROGRAM**

***Residential Case Manager – Johnson, VT***

This position is responsible for coordinating and facilitating ongoing supports and services to children and youth, residing in one of the Residential Homes. The Residential Case Manager will engage in extensive collaboration with other agencies and supports serving children and youth in need. This includes maintain client budgets to ensure spending is within budgeted amounts, ensure that receipts for client clothing, recreation and food are delivered in a timely manner to the LYFS Business Office, and maintain client prescriptions ensuring that all prescriptions are filled and handled/distributed correctly. Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in Human Services or related field is required and two years of human service delivery with children and families is preferred.

***Community Support Staff – Full & Part Time Positions – Widespread Locations in VT***

Actual shifts will vary by position, most requiring afternoon, evening and/or weekend work. Candidates must be flexible and patient, enthusiastic about working with youth and enjoy physical activity. Community Support Staff will provide a combination of supports for daily living. The role provides one-on-one supports in social, recreational, educational settings. Positions require the ability to engage in physical activities, some strenuous, including hiking, biking, fishing, canoeing, swimming, camping, etc. Prior experience working with youth that have emotional behavioral disorders is a plus.

***Residential Support Staff – Full & Part Time Positions – Westfield, VT & Johnson, VT***

Actual shifts will vary by position, most requiring afternoon, evening and/or weekend work. Candidates must be flexible, patient and enthusiastic about working with youth. Staff will provide a combination of supports for daily living and one-on-one supports in social, recreational and educational settings. Positions require the ability to engage in physical activities, some strenuous, including hiking, biking, fishing, canoeing, swimming, camping, etc. Prior experience working with youth that experiencing emotional behavioral disorders is a plus.
