Behavior Interventionists – Outdoor Adventure Education and Life Skills Focus! – Johnson & Hardwick, VT

This position will provide daily educational and behavioral support to individual students in an alternative school setting; providing opportunities for youth to make positive choices, gain self-confidence and learn skills that are critical to their lifelong development. The Interventionist will provide support in social, recreational, and daily living skills in school, community and outdoor education settings. The positions will support individualized academic plans, classroom based activities; community based service learning and school-to-work initiatives. Bachelor degree, or pursuing Bachelor Degree, preferably in human services. May have relevant experience in exchange for human services degree. These positions are full time and offer a comprehensive compensation and benefits package.

Substitute and Part-Time opportunities also available.

Bus Monitor – Part-Time – Newport – Johnson, VT

The Bus Monitor will provide supervision to students during transit to school in the morning as well as the return trip at the end of the school day. SUBSTITUTE CARE PROGRAM

Case Manager – Johnson, VT

Individual to provide case management and support for several clients within foster care program. Case Manager will directly supervise support staff as well as conduct weekly in-home visits with foster families. Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in Human Services or related field is required and two years of human service delivery with children and families is preferred. Community Support Staff – Full & Part Time Positions – Widespread Locations in VT
